

Job Posting: Summer Program Counselor

Job Duties: Under the direction of the Recreation Programmer & Recreation Director, the Summer Camp Counselors lead multiple types of activities with children in the Summer Playground Program. Activities include sports, arts & crafts, group games, swimming, and chaperoning field trips. The counselor must be a positive role model with exemplary leadership and communication skills.

The counselor should make relationship building a high priority at all times through the implementation of fun, inclusive, and engaging activities. The counselor is responsible for ensuring that the mission, purpose, image, and core values of the New Baltimore Parks & Recreation Department is conveyed in every aspect of camp.

Camp counselors will also be responsible for leading activities during the Summer Recess Program, a program held both before and after Summer Playground Program is over each day.

Days/Hours: Counselors work Monday through Friday each week of camp, including field trip days. 2022 camp is 8 weeks long, starting June 12th through August 11th. Applicant must be available to work on Saturday, July 8th for the Anchor Bay Triathlon and July 21 or 22 for the Bay Area Sports Show. Counselors will work approximately 30-40 hours per week. No camp 6/19-6/23, 7/3, 7/4, 7/7.

Qualifications:

- Summer Camp Counselors must be at least 16 years old and have relevant experience working with children.
- Must have a valid Michigan driver's license
- This position requires the capability of leading sports activities, arts and crafts activities, and other general games. The individual must be motivated, energetic, and able to communicate with participants and parents.
- Works well with others and is patient with both children and adults.
- Great communication skills.
- CPR/First Aid certification is preferred
