

Job Posting: Baseball Umpire

Job Duties: Under the direction of the Recreation Programmer & Recreation Director, Umpires are in charge of enforcing game rules and league regulations before, during and after each game assigned to them by the Umpire-In-Chief. The umpire will be in charge of making judgement calls, such as safe/out, ball/strike, fair/foul. The umpire is expected to uphold league safety regulations and maintain a professional attitude. The umpire is expected to work hard and position themselves accordingly to make an accurate call.

Days/Hours: Games are typically played in the evening hours, after 5pm, during the week. Some game assignments may be multiple games in a row.

Qualifications:

- Umpire must be at least 16 years old
- Must have a valid Michigan driver's license
- The umpire must be able to communicate effectively, both verbally and non-verbally
- Works well with others and is patient with both children and adults.
- A strong leadership attitude.
- Coachable, able to receive direction and a willingness to learn.
