
- Event Month: April
- Expected Attendance: Approx. 600 – 700 total people
- Projected Event Budget: \$1,350



Movie In The Park

This outdoor family movie event is co-organized with the New Baltimore Parks & Recreation Department and Park It Family Fun Nights. The event includes live music entertainment for 2 hours before the movie, as well as bounce houses, food options, free giveaways, and a family friendly movie on a 25 foot LED screen. The largest cost for the Parks and Recreation Department is the movie copy rights in order to show the movie.

- Event Month: August (additional date in July possible in 2017)
- Expected Attendance: 500 – 700 total people
- Projected Event Budget: \$500



Trick or Treat On Washington Street

This event is a major collaboration between the Parks and Recreation Department, local businesses, community churches, and community service groups. Every year, approximately 50 different businesses and groups get involved with this event in order to create a fun and safe holiday event for the families in the community. This event is free to the public, but it is asked that 2 canned good/non-perishable food items are donated for each child in attendance. Sponsorships help to keep this a free and public event for the Anchor Bay community. A local food pantry and a food program for children are the beneficiaries of these donations.

- Event Month: October
- Expected Attendance: 5,000+ total people
- Projected Event Budget: \$2,000-\$3,000



Christmas Craft Show

The Christmas Craft Show, hosted inside the Recreation Center, invites crafters to host a table to sell their hand crafted items to the public. The event is limited to people who make hand crafted goods and handmade items to sell. The event is typically held the Saturday prior to Black Friday and Shop Small Saturday, getting a jump start on the holiday shopping season. A special feature of the event, and a huge draw to the downtown area, is a live reindeer exhibit in the field adjacent to the Recreation Center. Families come to meet the reindeer and shop for unique holiday gifts for their friends and family at this annual event.

- Event Month: November
- Expected Attendance: 600-800 total people
- Projected Event Budget: \$700



Soggy Doggy

The New Baltimore Recreation Department hosts two Saturdays a year where dogs are welcome to swim in the typically pet-free public beach at Walter and Mary Burke Park. Sponsorship for this event would help to fund the cost of giveaways for the pets and families who attend.

- Expected Attendance: Approx. 50 people
- Projected Event Budget: \$200
